

On Motion of Mr. Sciambra seconded by Mr. Ackel, the following resolution was adopted:

RESOLUTION NO. 10740

A resolution to the United States Corps of Engineers requesting the Corp to reimburse the Pontchartrain Levee District for interim Lakefront Flood Protection construction in Jefferson Parish and to make adequate provision in the future to reimburse the Parish of Jefferson for permanent flood protection construction in Jefferson Parish as proposed by the Lakefront Reclamation Project.

WHEREAS, The Federal Government proposes a One Hundred Million Dollar construction project for Lake Pontchartrain and Vicinity Hurricane Protection, and

WHEREAS, The Parish of Jefferson is one of the beneficiaries under this plan, and

WHEREAS, The Pontchartrain Levee District is presently constructing an interim protection levee of fourteen feet in height along Lake Pontchartrain on a crash program basis, and

WHEREAS, Plans and specification were accepted by the Jefferson Parish Council on February 17, 1967 to reclaim the Lakefront which plans provide for the construction of permanent flood protection facilities along the Lake,

with the exception of the Lakefront

THE JEFFERSON PARISH COUNCIL RESOLVES to request the United States Corp of Engineers to reimburse the Pontchartrain Levee District for funds paid by the said District to construct the interim protection levee of fourteen feet in Jefferson Parish.

THE JEFFERSON PARISH COUNCIL RESOLVES FURTHER to request the United States Corp of Engineers to make adequate provision in the future to reimburse the Parish of Jefferson should any funds be expended by this Parish to construct permanent flood protection facilities along Lake Pontchartrain in accordance with the proposed Lakefront Reclamation Project.

THE JEFFERSON PARISH COUNCIL RESOLVES FURTHER
to send certified copies of this resolution to United States Corp
of Engineers, The Pontchartrain Levee District, Senators Long and
Ellender and Representative Boggs of the Congressional Delegation.
